We are honored to do the work we do. Let me explain.

Honor means respect for the dignity of all we serve, the privilege to be stewards of important, meaningful work, and expresses our esteem for partners who make success possible — our donors, colleagues and volunteers who invest in and support our work. Catholic Social Services of Washtenaw is focused on what will make a difference to those without hope in our community.

In 2015:

- CSSW doubled the number of foster care parents licensed to provide a home to children separated from their families because of abuse or neglect issues.
- Funding changes in the Community Mental Health system left hundreds of chronically mentally ill individuals without the support on which they had come to depend. CSSW's Behavioral Health department increased its ability to respond to those who require medication checks and a more intensive counseling relationship.
- CSSW helped seniors express their experience with substance abuse through the PhotoVoice traveling exhibit. These photographs and first person narratives describe the often unspoken reality of complex lives.
- Our annual Birthmother's Day on the Sunday before Mother's
 Day is a special event to recognize and give tribute to mothers
 who made adoption plans for their babies. Such a momentous
 sacrifice changes lives in a profound way, yet may otherwise go
 without acknowledgement.

In 2016, we continue to seek out those who have been overlooked in our community's economic recovery. Our Behavioral Health department will expand further to offer more comprehensive service, collaborating with primary health care and case management. To ensure forward progress, we will offer increased support to those returning to community life from incarceration or struggles with substance abuse. Elder abuse prevention continues as a priority.

We draw inspiration and perseverance from the courage and hard work of the individuals and families in our programs. Please honor us with your attention, your support and your financial help. Your partnership makes all the difference.





2015 Demographics


Program Areas




Age Ranges







Basic Needs

A healthy community gives special attention to those who are poor and on the margins of society.

We believe

There is an inherent dignity present in each member of our community that compels us to serve those who are poor and struggling at the margins of our society. Through encouragement for families with emergency food needs or daily support of others striving to live independently, we offer a path that maximizes the potential and reality of each person to realize a fulfilling, safe place in our community.

- Nearly 700 households with an annual income below \$15,000 received an emergency three to five day supply of food. Most recipients are working individuals who report regular food insecurity.
- Excessive ambulance use has dropped by an average of 55% for individuals struggling with homelessness, mental illness, and multiple other issues. Through case management, participants were connected to community service providers and resources increasing the safety of participants.

Children & Families

The moral test of a society is how it treats its most vulnerable members. Children need our protection.

We believe

Every child is entitled to the physical and emotional safety to build resilience, to ensure school performance, and the ability to develop good relationships in the future. In the past year, the safety, welfare and hopeful future of our vulnerable children has been strengthened.

- 226 young victims of sexual and physical abuse received crisis intervention, emotional support, and coordinated case management by social work, legal and medical professionals as the case moved through the legal system.
- 235 new parents in specialized groups reported substantive improvement in positive parenting skills and understanding the development and health needs of their children.
- 34 children became the newest members of welcoming, supportive families through adoptions for children with special needs and open adoption where children may maintain a relationship with the birth mother.

Counseling

Human dignity can only be realized and protected within the context of relationships with others and with the wider community.

We believe

Human dignity depends on the ability to have positive relationships with others and to successfully navigate the demands of everyday activities. Behavioral Health Counseling offers help to all members of our community to work through the issues that keep individuals from enjoying satisfying and productive lives.

- 84% of our clients report that they are better able to interact with family and others in the community.
- 86% achieve two personal goals important to them such as paying rent on time, taking medications regularly or repairing a relationship.

Safer Communities

Every person has a fundamental right to share in those things required for human decency — starting with food, shelter and clothing, employment, health care and education.



Our community is stronger and safer when ex-offenders and others who have made terrible mistakes have a genuine opportunity to make better choices going forward. Too often, lack of options for housing and work undermines even the most determined. Program services incorporating strong standards of accountability, monitoring, and support of these clients offer the best chance to rebuild devastated lives.

- 178 homeless returning prisoners were successfully diverted from the homeless shelter to the housing program.
- 85% of domestic violence offenders report a first-time increased understanding of their abusive behavior and less than 2% resort to violence while participating in the year-long program.

Seniors

The dignity of the human person is the starting point for a moral vision in society.

We believe

Seniors deserve lives of dignity and the opportunity to live safely in a place of their own choosing. Sixty-five percent of our senior clients report incomes less than \$20,000 annually. Purchasing good, safe, reliable support services is cost prohibitive for all but the very few, and adult children often find themselves in a struggle between simultaneously supporting their children and their parents.

For more than 2,500 seniors in our county, specific help from CSSW has changed vulnerable situations to more stable ones.

- 90 caregivers report adult day services and in-home visits have decreased stress levels.
- 286 seniors report feeling more secure through home repair services and installation of home safety devices.
- 1,183 seniors and disabled adults received \$586,000 in refunds through tax assistance, many of whom were at 70% of poverty level.
- 620 seniors received referral and advocacy services for issues and problems including substance and elder abuse.
- 82 grandparents raising their grandchildren received supportive services to maintain a stable home for their grandchildren.




Volunteers from First Congregational Church of Ann Arbor had a service project on a Sunday instead of a Sunday Service.





"Crooked Path" PhotoVoice Project

Did you know substance abuse is one of the fastest growing health problems among older adults? To raise community awareness. and illustrate

this growing concern, the Bi-County Senior Connection created PhotoVoice to give seniors, caregivers, and their families the opportunity to share personal experiences of substance abuse through photography and narrative. PhotoVoice has been on display at 19 local hospitals, senior centers, and social service agencies. The Bi-County Senior Connection is a partnership with CSSW, Livingston County Catholic Charities, and the University of Michigan Senior Wellness program.





TJ was sixteen years old when he was sentenced to life in prison. Despite all obstacles, TJ used his sentence as a time for growth and giving back. He joined support groups and sought psychotherapy. He took classes, worked, and volunteered

with other inmates. Finally, after 40 years, he walked into a vastly different world from the one he'd left at 16.

TJ explains that the things we take for granted - finding a job, setting up a bank account, using a cell phone — are tremendous obstacles for someone re-entering the community. He graciously talks about the Washtenaw Prisoner Re-Entry Program (WPR) and the power of small gifts and big connections. The WPR staff connected him with resources such as employment opportunities, clothing support, and transportation. They believe in him and in his rehabilitation.

Today, TJ is halfway to a bachelor's degree in pre-law while balancing his classes with his jobs and volunteer work. TJ is committed to making something of his own life and the world a better place.




